I am also humbled to share with you that at our quarterly board meeting on Wednesday there were resounding words of recognition, gratitude, and encouragement expressed by our collective group of volunteer board members towards our team at St. John's--many who have served in this capacity for years, some having expertise to truly recognize the outstanding work being done here, and all who are proud to be a part of our extended team of supporters. You should also know that our board has raised \$50,000 in direct support of St. John's securing additional PPE to protect our residents and staff. This fundraising effort has been opened up to the greater community to further support the expanded services to our senior residents at this time and another \$11,000 has already been raised.
