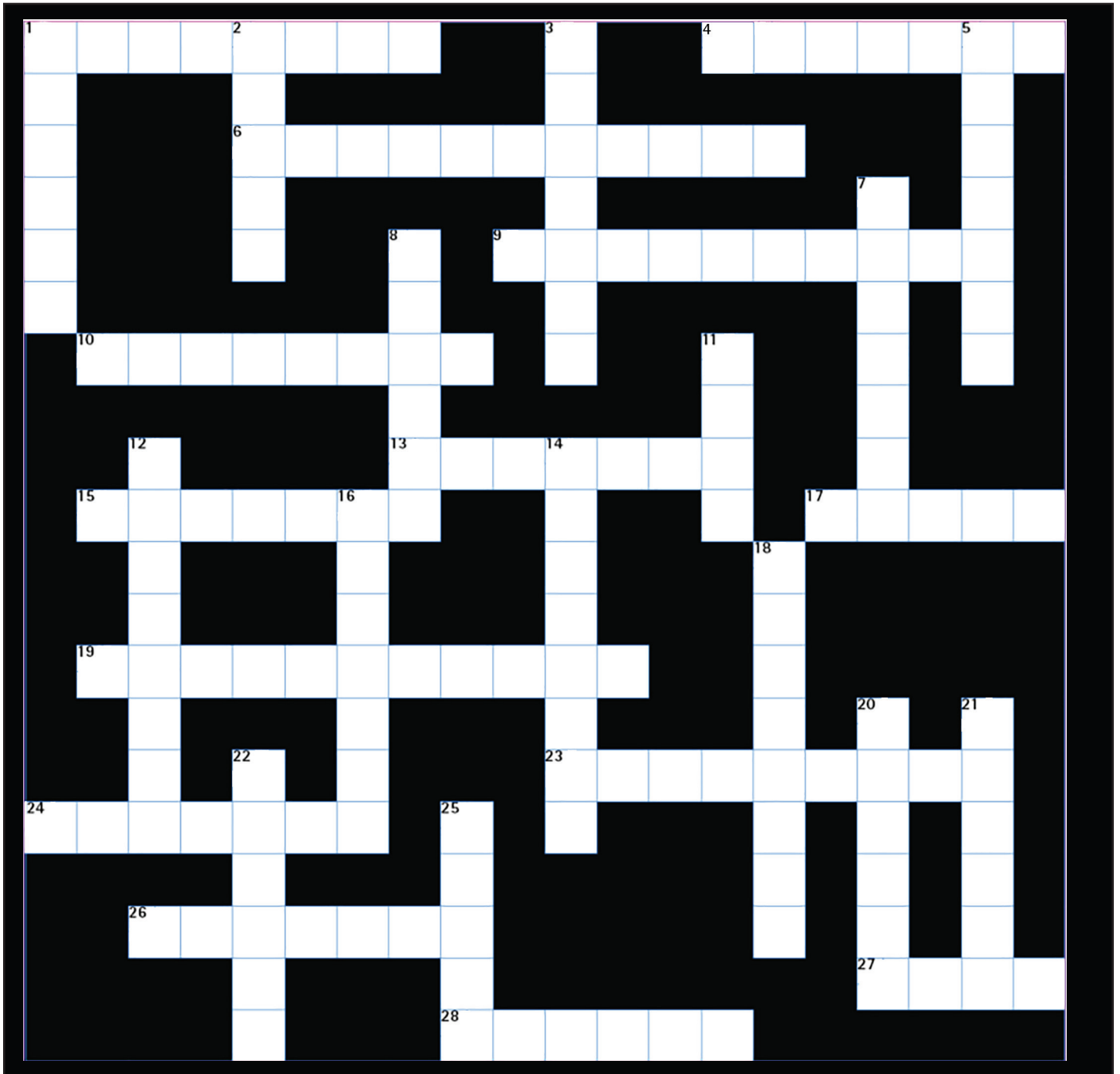


Crossword Puzzle with a Rochester Theme December 21, 2020
