

COVID-19 VACCINE

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS FOR STAFF

When is my first opportunity to get vaccinated at St. John's Home?

Walgreens Pharmacy is scheduled to begin providing COVID-19 vaccine to St. John's residents and select staff members on Wednesday, December 30, 2020.

Which COVID-19 vaccine would I get?

St. John's residents and staff members will be given the Pfizer (BNT162b2) vaccine on December 30 as well as second doses of the same vaccine on January 20, 2021.

Am I vaccinated after the first dose?

No, the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine requires a second dose 21-days later. Walgreens is scheduled to return on Wednesday, January 20, 2021 to administer the second dose for those receiving the vaccine on December 30, 2020.

Why is it important to get vaccinated?

Nursing homes have been profoundly affected by COVID-19 in 2020. For the health and well-being of those who live and work at St. John's Home, it is vitally important for residents and staff members to receive the vaccine as soon as possible.

What should I know about the Pfizer vaccine?

The two-dose Pfizer vaccine has been 95% effective against COVID-19 in clinical trials and is already being given to health care and other essential workers around the country and here in Rochester.

Are there any additional incentives for getting vaccinated?

Each employee completing both vaccination doses will receive a \$100 gift card and be entered in a drawing to win additional prizes.
